ANTIGEN DISTRIBUTION AND SPECIFICITY:

The Mouse CD34 antigen is a marker on hematopoietic progenitor cells of myeloid origin. This CD34 antigen is found on subsets of stem cell populations— and this can differ between particular antibodies to CD34.

This monoclonal antibody recognizes an epitope of CD34 antigen, which is **sensitive** to neuraninadase treatment.

CLONE: ANTIGENIX AMERICA clone MEC14

Immunoglobulin chain composition: RAT IgG2a

CONJUGATION: Fluorescein isothiocyanate; R-Phycoerythrin.

HANDLING AND STORAGE:

All forms are supplied as 1.0 mL of liquid. Fluorochromes should be protected from prolonged exposure to light. Reagents will be in a medium containing 0.01M phosphate-buffered saline, pH 7.4, 0.1% BSA and 0.1% sodium azide.

These preparations should be diluted in a protein-containing or other stabilizing medium to a concentration suitable for use in specific protocols. All reagents in a liquid state should be stored at $2-8^{\circ}$ C when not in use. Small aliquots of purified (uncongugated only) reagent may be frozen, undiluted, at -20° C. Avoid freeze-thaw cycles.

PRODUCT USE:

Use 10-20uL per test to stain no more than one million cells.; For immuno-histochemistry, purified Anti-CD34 should be diluted, using enough reagent to cover the tissue section or cytoprep.

- * Studies of myeloid leukemias and progenitor cells.
- * FACS analysis of CD34 bearing cells.
- * Studies of the control mechanisms of hemopoiesis.

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
