DESCRIPTION:

Human Interleukin -1 Receptor Antagonist(IL-1RA) is a cytokine produced by monocytes, macrophages, neutrophils, fibroblasts and corneal epithelial cells that inhibits inflammatory process. Human IL-1RA competitively blocks the receptors for IL-1 alpha and IL-1 beta. The medical application of IL-1RA may be important in the control or treatment of diseases such as psoriasis, sepsis, rheumatoid arthritis, CML, and other inflammatory conditions. Human IL-1RA is a 17.2 kDa protein containing 153 amino acid residues.

Purity greater than 98% by HPLC analysis. Endotoxin level less than 0.1 ng per ug IL-1RA.

HANDLING AND STORAGE:

Spin-down vial before reconstitution. Lyophilized, purified IL-1RA should be reconstituted with **distilled water** to concentration approximately 100.0 ug/mL. Further dilute in PBS or other aqueous buffers. This can be stored in small aliquots frozen, with addition of 0.1% BSA, at -20 $^{\circ}$ C. for up to 3 months.

BIOACTIVITY:

Half-maximal inhibitory effect measured at 40.0 ng/mL in presence of 50.0 pg/mL of human IL-1 alpha in stimulation of mouse D10S cells.
