SPECIFICITY:

Human interleukin -15, produced in BALB/c mice using highly purified recombinant human IL-15 as immunogen. Purified by protein A affinity chromatography.

IMMUNOGLOBULIN CHAIN COMPOSITION: Mouse IgG1, kappa chains

SOURCE: Murine ascites fluid.

PURIFICATION METHOD: Protein A affinity chromatography. Sterile filtered, lyophilized from PBS.

RESEARCH APPLICATIONS:

Quantitative immunoassays; Identification of IL 15 in tissue sections and body fluids. Not currently tested for neutralization.

ELISA: Direct ELISA testing gave titre of 1:18,000 achieved (from 1.0 mg/mL antobody concentration) using polyclonal goat anti-mouse IgG as secondary detection antibody.

HANDLING AND STORAGE:

Lyophilized, purified monoclonal antibody upon reconstitution with 0.5 ml of sterile water will be in a medium containing 0.01M phosphate-buffered saline, pH 7.4. These preparations should be diluted in a protein-containing or other stabilizing medium to a concentration suitable for use in specific protocols. Lyophilized reagents should be stored at -20° C until reconstitution. For long-term storage, freeze aliquots and store at -20 Deg. C. Avoid repeat freeze-thaw.
